### **Prescription Discounts**

After a meeting this morning with a Senior Citizen Department Coordinator, Mayor Robert G. Lowery, Sr. announced that the City of Florissant will be participating in a "Discount Card Prescription Program" through the National League of Cities. This program can possibly save on an average 20% off the full retail cost of prescription medications. This program will benefit residents who are without health insurance, a traditional pharmacy benefit plan, or have prescriptions not covered by insurance.

Another program available is through the Greater North County Chamber of Commerce. This program has no restrictions to membership, no income or age limitations, and residents are not required to fill out an application. This program was launched to help uninsured and underinsured residents of Greater North County afford their prescription medications.
