Florissant to Participate in the 4th Nationwide D.E.A. "Drug Take Back Program" Saturday, April 28, 2012



The City of Florissant will again join forces with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) along with other government, community, public health and law enforcement partners to participate in a nationwide prescription drug "Take-Back" initiative that seeks to prevent increased pill abuse and theft. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.

The City of Florissant will have three collection sites for people to drop off their expired, unused and unwanted prescription drugs for destruction on:

Saturday, April 28, 2012 (10:00 A.M.-2:00 P.M.)

Tablets, capsules, and all other solid dosage forms will be collected. **Intravenous solutions, injectibles, and syringes will not be accepted.**
