

## MAYOR SCHNEIDER DELIVERS YET ANOTHER PLEA TO GOVERNOR NIXON'S OFFICE TO ALLOW THE FLORISSANT ROTARY TO CONTINUE OPERATING THE MISSOURI VEHICLE LICENSE OFFICE IN FLORISSANT



While at the Capital Mayor Schneider delivers another personal plea to Governor Nixon's office urging him to intervene in behalf of the Florissant Rotary Club in their appeal to reverse the decision of the Department of Revenue to take the vehicle license away from the nonprofit Florissant Rotary Club and give it to a for profit individual.

In the appeal Mayor Schneider pointed out that the state contract with the Florissant Rotary was the perfect PUBLIC/NON PROFIT partnership with all of the profits going to help the less fortunate in our society.

The Mayor pointed out that Rotary gave the profits to organizations such as Valley Industries Sheltered Workshop for Developmentally Challenged Adults, Marygrove Home for abused and unwanted children and The Emergency Assistance Ministry TEAM food Pantry to feed the hungry. Mayor Schneider pointed out that there is no possible way that the State could direct the small increase in income they would receive back into Missouri society and achieve even a fraction of the benefit now delivered by Rotary.
