CHARGES ISSUED RELATED TO A ROBBERY AT WATERFORD AND ST. ANTHONY

FLORISSANT, MO- Warrants were issued August 16th for Toreyan Moore by the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office for the charge of Robbery 1st Degree, Assault 1st Degree, Unlawful Use of a Weapon and Three counts of Armed Criminal Action and on Anthony Tyler for Robbery 1st degree and Armed Criminal Action.

The Florissant Police Department responded to the intersection of Waterford and St. Anthony in reference to a Robbery that just occurred.

The victim advised that two black male suspects, later identified as:

Toreyan Moore
05-17-1999
4900 blk. of Bluesage
St. Louis County, MO 63033

And

Anthony Tyler
02-16-2000
200 blk of Barto
Hazelwood MO, 63042

Approached him as he was walking near the intersection of Waterford and St. Anthony at approximately 3:45pm on August 15th, produced a firearm, and forcibly took the victim's backpack, cell phone and other items. The two suspects were last seen running on foot through a backyard.

A short time later, the victim's family was able to track the stolen cell phone to an area near Grandview Shopping Plaza. The victim's family member and another subject responded to the area to confront the suspects regarding the stolen items. Moore fired shots at the victims who were in a motor vehicle. The victims in the vehicle identified Moore as the shooter.

Toreyan Moore was quickly arrested and confessed to robbing the first victim and to discharging the firearm.

Moore is being held at the St. Louis County Jail on a \$100,000 cash only bond.

Anthony Tyler was also identified as one of the persons who robbed the victim using a firearm. Tyler was arrested and confessed to participating in the crime.
