The AGC of Missouri represents the united voice of the construction industry throughout the state of Missouri. AGC of Missouri represents over 525 commercial, industrial, heavy and highway contractors, industry partners and related firms in 110 counties across the state and operates offices in St. Louis and Jefferson City.
