Additionally, a request is being made to demolish the front porch that was added without a permit and remove all overgrowth vegetation, old stumps and trees that prevent the installation of the fence.

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132		Steve Purgahn is requesting a COA for the replacement of portions of the
133		existing foundation. The amount of foundation that is being repaired is
133		approximately 40 linear feet. This foundation has shifted over the years
134		causing the walls to settle, the floor timbers to rest on dirt in some areas and
135		the deterioration of portions of the sill plate. The foundation of the left rear
130		elevation is constructed of dry stacked limestone. This foundation is
		approximately 30" deep by 12" wide. This foundation has deteriorated due
138		approximation by used by 12 white. This foundation has deteriorated due

139 140 141 142		to water damage, which led to the deterioration of the wall sill plate and the settling of the rear wall by 6". Both areas of the foundation will be replaced with a poured concrete footing and foundation.

With all the extreme weather and water damage the house was shifting on the current foundation causing the walls and floor to settle. Steve also explained that extensive work on the interior and back of house will also be required. Dianne explained to the commission that we are only reviewing and granting a COA for the foundation. Additional work to the house will have to be re-submitted. Doug made a motion seconded by Gary Meyer to grant COA# 2025-087 for the repair approximately 40' linear feet of the foundation using poured concrete. All voted to approve.
