







The City of Florissant is proud to announce that we will be co-hosting The Tour de Florissant Bicycle Races Missouri State Championship on Saturday, August 5th. This event will bring a large sense of community and competition to the streets of Old Town in a new fashion that might remind some of the cycling races that occurred in Old Town decades ago.

The part we need to communicate with you, the residents and business owners, is that this race will be taking place on the streets of Old Town and certain homes and businesses will not have access to their driveways or lots for long portions of the day. We realize this is an inconvenience for the residents who live in these homes and businesses, but we also feel this event can bring a lot of economic activity and pride for the community as well. You will be able to access your home, but your cars will need to be 1 block off the route for the duration of the day if you wish to leave by vehicle. The races will happen from 730am- 4:30 pm. Emergency services will not be interrupted.



The Route

- -Start on St. Francois in front of the VFW heading East
- -Make a left on Jefferson at Fleck's Appliance heading North
- -Make a right on St. Antoine after passing Hendel's going East
- -Make a right on Lafayette at Henke's Tavern going South
- -Make a right on St. Francois at Dooley's going West
- -Make a left on Jefferson at Made By Lia going South
- -Make a right on St. Catherine after passing Korte's going West
- -Make a right on St. Pierre at Davison Park going North
- -Make a right on St. Francois near Bunkers towards the VFW going East
- -Each race is 50 laps
