CITY OF FLORISSANT TO HOST RECYCLING EVENT WITH MIDWEST

Mayor Lowery is pleased to announce that the City of Florissant has joined up with MRC Recycling again to host a Document Destruction and Recycling Event on <u>Saturday, April 26th,</u> <u>from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.</u> The event will be held in <u>St. Ferdinand Park</u>, rain or shine. Signs will be posted throughout the park, directing people where to go. This event is open to the public.

<u>What to bring to be shredded:</u> bank statements, tax records, credit card statements, invoices, and anything with your name and address on it. There is no need to remove paper clips, binder clips, or staples. Please note that MRC will collect all of the documents and paper for destruction and recycling in gaylord boxes to maximize the capacity of material collection and the flow of traffic. Documents will not be shredded on-site, they will be collected and transported to MRC's facility to be destructed there.
