The following items have been modified and are now a part of the contract documents for the above referenced project.

The building will be open for review on Wednesday, February 22, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon). Contractors who did not attend the meeting on February 15, 2017 will have the opportunity to sign the attendance sheet, as required.

- 1. The chain link fence and the ornamental fence are both six feet (6'-0") in height. This is for Section 32 31 00.
- 2. Gate operation for cantilevered gate at ornamental fence shall be DKS Door King 9100 Commercial, or equal, with the following features:
  - Self-adjusting, no maintenance magnetic limits
  - Partial-open feature
  - Anti-tailgating feature
  - Gate tracker reporting output
  - Posts for plug-in loop detectors
  - Two convenience outlets
  - Fail-secure
  - Programming switches
  - Built-in reset switch
  - Built-in power On/Off switch

- 3. Tuckpointing will require a base bid of 200 S.F. with cracks either routed or filled with sealant or mortar depending on location and condition. Penetrations /old anchor holes will be filled with mortar. A request for an add/deduct per S.F. has been added to the bid form.
- 4. All exterior control joints will be cut out and new backer rod and sealant will be installed.
- 5. For bidding purposes, the patching and repair of the EIFS should be calculated for an area of 50 S.F. No add/deduct will be required.
- 6. Section 09 30 00-Tiling has been revised. On Part 2, 2.1, A, delete American Olean Tile Co. and Crossville Porcelain Stone. Dal Tile is the only allowed manufacturer.
- 7. Section 09 30 00-Tiling has been revised. In Part 2, 2.2-A, delete Items 9 and 10. For specific product refer to page A5.2 of the drawings.
- 8. The Dal Tile Ceramic Tile, Portfolio, Colorbody, Noce PF II shall be 12"x24" in size. This is for Sheet A-5.2.
- 9. Section 06 20 00-Finish Carpentry and Millwork: Part 2, 2.4, A, revise to Custom Standards. Delete Premium Standards.

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- 10. Sheet A51-Partition Types Clarifications:
  - --Partition Type A: will not have insulation (See attached Sheet A5.1A).
  - --Partition Type A1: is added and contains sound batt insulation
  - --Both types, A and A1 should have stud length of 12' as indicated.
  - --Partition Types C, E, F and G: All indicated a wood plate and kicker. The wood plate should be a 2x pressure treated lumber and kickers should be 35/8" metal stands 20 GA or 33 MILS.
- 11. A revised Sheet A1.1 has been included to show locations of Type A and Type A1 partitions. The bench in the holding cell has also been added,
- 12. Section 07 50 50-TPO Membrane Roofing-Part 2, 2.1, A: add Versico Roofing Systems as an acceptable manufacturer. All other specified items remain as originally documented for this Section.
- 13. Section 08 71 00-Door Hardware: Best Locks and Stanley Hinges are acceptable manufacturers.
- 14. Section 10 51 13-Metal Lockers: Bradford Systems is an acceptable manufacturer, provided the product supplied meets or exceeds the specified product and no adjustments to the design layouts are required.
- 15. The Holding Cell should be equipped with a wall mounted steel bench on the east wall of the room. See attached partial plan
- 16. Page 3 of the Table of Contents has been revised. The Mechanical section is now listed as Division 21 and the Electrical section is now listed as Division 26.
- 17. The Pre-Bid Agenda is attached to this Addendum No. 2.

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- 18. The Sign-in Sheets listing attendees to the Pre-Bid meeting are attached to this Addendum No. 2.
- 19. A clarification regarding the unit price for the steel deck replacement. The contractor is responsible for providing new deck which matches the existing profile. Base bid to be 2000 sq. ft. and finish should be standard shop primer.
- 20. For builders risk insurance, contactors should base the policy on a \$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollar) deductable.

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21. Electronic strikes to be provided by the access control contractor.

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22. The Table of Contents, Section 00 01 10 has been modified to revise the headings to coordinate with the 6 digit CSI format. The headings for Division 21, Division 22, Division 23, Division 26, and Division 28 have been added. Revised pages of the Table of contents are included as attachments.


