Report from the Director of Parks and Recreation:

- The Splash Pad ribbon cutting was held on Oct. 2nd and was very well attended. The splash pad itself opened for use on Saturday, Sept. 28th.
- Staff has begun working on the new publication which will join the brochure and the Focus, and it will be called the Florissant Spotlight. The first issue of this should hit everyone's home the week of November 25th.
- Work on the 2020 Budget continues with a public hearing on Monday, Oct. 14th for a council public hearing. Work study sessions with the council on the budget will be held Oct. 23rd & 24th.
- JJE Pool is shut down due to mechanical difficulties until further notice.
- The new Zamboni came in last week. Ice rink staff is working hard in getting the ice rink cleaned up and will begin making ice on Monday and Tuesday of next week. The rink is scheduled to open Oct. 21st barring any warmer weather.
- The exercise equipment at St. Ferdinand has been installed.
- The Ga Ga Ball pit will be installed towards the end of the month, the Boy Scout is still looking for about \$300 to finish the project.
- Nerf Wars was held last week with approximately 50 participants.
- Halloween Dance for 5-8th graders will be held on Oct. 18th, 6:30-9 at JFK.
- Boo Bash will be held here on Oct. 26th, 12-2 p.m.
- Fall Festival is this Sunday.
- Superhero Date Night is Nov. 8th, 6:30-8:30 p.m. at JFK
- The Suicide prevention race had close to 380 runners and about 200 spectators.

Rev Robinson asked about seating outside the Splash Pad. Cheryl replied that there would only be seats on the inside.

Jason asked about signs to be posted at Splash Pad. Cheryl stated they are already there.

Kristina said the rocks are hard to walk on and could they be changed to concrete. Cheryl said maybe down the road it could be put in the budget. Monica asked about putting that in the next step. Cheryl said she didn't think so because the grant didn't have it in the scope.

Monica asked where the playground would be located at in reference to the Splash Pad.
