

What Is Prop A?

Prop A is a general obligation bond issue. If passed by voters it will generate \$9 million for major new improvements and renovation of Florissant's aquatic recreation facilities. Based on eleven cents per \$100 assessed valuation, the cost would be approximately \$3 per month on an average Florissant home.

Prop U Helps Our Community Not A Double Tax



What Is Prop U?

It would require out-of-state vendors to collect local sales tax. Passage will NOT increase the local tax rate you pay when shopping anywhere in Florissant or anywhere else in Missouri. It will not increase what you pay when shopping at your favorite local businesses.

How Will Prop U Benefit Florissant?
