Florissant to Request Release of Community Development Block Grant Funds

The City of Florissant will request the release of 2022 CDBG funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on December 19, 2022, following a two-week period in which the public will have the opportunity to comment on the slated use of the funds.

The Florissant 2022 CDBG Annual Action Plan identifies community needs and has been proposed for the following projects:

- The Home Improvement Project will provide \$7,000 zero-percent interest, five-year forgivable loans to low-to-moderate level income households within the city limits of Florissant, MO
- Home Improvement Mechanical grants up to \$5,000 for the replacement of HVAC and/or Water Heaters to eligible, low to moderate income households throughout Florissant
- Project IMPACT-Assist helps Florissant residents who need modifications to their home due to age and/or disability to allow them to live independently. Grants up to \$3,000 for accessibility items such as, ramps, grab bars, and other items to improve accessibility. Funds are available to rental or owneroccupied residents.
