

You will **NOT** be allowed to enter the Courtroom wearing the following inappropriate clothing:

**PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED.** NO Extremely short mini-skirts or short-shorts, pajama pants, spaghetti straps, crop tops, open mid-drift, dirty clothes, slippers, being barefoot and without foot covering of any type, halter tops or tank tops allowed in the courtroom. Bailiffs will **STOP** you from entering the courtroom.
