Family and friends gathered in front of 126 rue St. Francois on Wednesday, September 24 to unveil the 20th Walk Through History plaque in honor of the late Charlotte Ballard before the last Wednesday Night Out festivities which was held at Hendels Cafe.

After her husband Lawrence passed away in 1956 she became the sole owner of Ballard Plumbing. In 1959 she was the first woman in Missouri to hold a Master Plumber and Drain Layers license. After retiring from the plumbing business in 1975 she devoted her efforts to community service. She was a charter member of the Florissant Valley Historical Society, past president, secretary and for 18 years board member of the Florissant Valley Sheltered Workshop.
