Sexual Assault 2500 blk of Dove

FLORISSANT, MO- On April 2nd at approximately 12:30 am officers were dispatched to the 2500 blk of Dove in reference to a motor vehicle theft. The victim stated that she was in her vehicle in driveway when she was approached by a Black Male identified as:

Early to mid-20's
approximately 6'0 tall and 150 lbs.
medium complexion and shoulder length dreadlock hair

The suspect was also described as having one large star tattoo on his torso with three smaller star tattoos on the left and right side of the larger star.

The suspect was wearing a black skull cap, grey mask, black hooded jacket and Black pants.

The victim was exiting her vehicle and the suspect approached her displaying a black firearm. The victim was forced back into the vehicle and was taken to a nearby bank where she was forced to withdraw money from an ATM. The victim was then taken to an adjacent apartment complex where she was sexually assaulted by the suspect and released in a different apartment complex near Morningaire Circle and North Hanley Road in Hazelwood.

The victim's vehicle is described as a:

2004 Chevrolet Monte Carlo (Silver)
With Black wheels and tinted windows
Missouri license plate (SP7-X2W)

In addition to following numerous leads, Florissant Investigators are reviewing old cases for similarities and contacting neighboring jurisdictions to inquire if they have had similar instances.

The Florissant Police Department encourages anyone with information on the location of the victim's Silver Chevrolet Monte Carlo or a possible identity of the above mentioned suspect to contact the Florissant Detective Bureau at 314-831-7000.
