The Landmark and Historic District Commission (LHDC) of the City of Florissant met at the
 Florissant City Hall on Monday October 28, 2019 in the 2nd conference room at 6:30 p.m., with

Kent Miller as chair.

16 INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

Commission members introduced themselves along with staff members, Phil Lum, Building
Commissioner, Dianne Lehmann, recording clerk, Kent Miller-Chair, Steve Frank- member,
Christine Keil-member, Gary Meyer- member, Patty Sosa-member, Steve Siebe-member. Also
present was Tim Lee, representing Old Town Partners.

ROLL CALL

Steve Frank, Gary Meyer, Patty Sosa, Kent Miller, Steve Siebe, and Christine Keil were in attendance. There being a quorum the meeting was called to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Kent Miller asked if the commission had opportunity to review the minutes submitted. Patty
 Sosa made a motion to approve, seconded by Steve Siebe. All approved and motion carried,
 minutes were approved.

At this time Kent Miller asked if the commission would consider hearing new business to hear
 Old Town Partners' request for a COA prior to other business. Chris made a motion to hear new
 business, seconded by Patty Sosa all agreed and it was decided to move forward with New
 Business.

44 45 Item 1 Request COA for the repair of the wood porch, railing and steps at 601 rue 46 St. Charles commonly known as the Girardier House. Replacement material 47 will be wood painted white. 48 49 Tim Lee representing Old Town Partner explained that recently the group had 50 inspections done of the house and it was determined that the front porch needed 51 quite a bit of repair. This included spindles, hand rails and floor boards. 52 Handyman True Value Hardware is going to do the repair work. The work to be 53 done is repaint the handrails and spindles in white to match the existing trim and 54 replace in damaged or loose floor boards in the front porch and stain to match. Phil 55 Lum explained to the Commission that this is a responsible request because this is 56 a repair that will stay true to the integrity of the home. Kent Miller asked if there 57 were any questions for the petitioner and there were none. Gary Meyer made a 58 motion to grant a certificate of appropriateness for the repair and repainting of the 59 hand rails, spindles and floor boards. All painting will be similar in color to 60 existing trim and flooring. Steve Siebe seconded the motion, Steve Frank and 61 Christine Kiel abstained from voting because they are members of Old Town 62 Partners. Kent Miller, Gary Meyer, Steve Siebe and Patty Sosa voted in favor of 63 the COA. 64 65 66 Item 2 Request COA for the replacement of the existing cedar shake roof at 601 rue 67 St. Charles commonly known as the Girardier House. Replacement material 68 will be cedar shake. 69 70 Tim Lee representing Old Town Partners explained during that same inspection it 71 was determined that the roof was in really bad shape and needed to be replaced. 72 After considering replacing the roof with a cedar like composite the group decided 73 to replace the roof with cedar shake shingles which is what is currently on the roof 74 and would be a more historically correct replacement. The cost is twice as much 75 as the composite roofing but Old Town Partners wanted to stay true to the 76 building. Tim Lee explained that COPAL construction would be completing the 77 roof replacement. 78 79 Kent Miller asked if there were any questions for the petitioner and there were 80 none. Gary Meyer made a motion to grant a certificate of appropriateness for the 81 replacement of the roof with cedar shake shingles. Steve Siebe seconded the 82 motion, Steve Frank and Christine Kiel abstained from voting because they are 83 members of Old Town Partner board. Kent Miller, Gary Meyer, Steve Siebe and 84 Patty Sosa voted in favor of the COA. Steve Siebe wanted to extend his gratitude 85 to Old Town Partners for spending the extra money and staying true to the house. 86 He wanted all members of Old Town Partner to know that it was the right way to 87 move forward 88

91		St. Ferdinand commonly known as the Bockrath-Weise House. Replacement	
92		material will be cedar shake.

94		Phil Lum explained that we have a very similar situation for the Weise House roof.	
95		The roof has sustained some storm damage. As a result of the damage to the roof	
96		there is a hole in the floor in one of the front rooms and damage to the walls and	
97		ceilings. Phil explained that the Parks Department has been using the home as	
98		storage and the home has fallen into disrepair. A recent trip to the house with the	
99		Mayor was promising as he ordered the parks personnel to clean up the interior	
100		and do some stabilization work to the exterior. The Mayor asked about volunteers	
101		that may help with the restoration. Dianne said she thought that wouldn't be a	
102		problem. Gary Meyer asked what were the plans for the building. Phil told him	
103		we had many interested parties for the building. The most pressing work needed	
104		on the exterior is to clean out gutter gardens and clean out the window wells to	
105		help eliminate the other water issues.

107		Chris asked who would do the roof replacement. Dianne answered that we already	
108		had a bid from COPAL construction but we would need to go out Kent Miller	
109		asked if there were any questions for the petitioner and there were none. Gary	
110		Meyer made a motion that we grant a certificate of appropriateness for the	
111		replacement of the roof with cedar shake shingles. Steve Siebe seconded the	
112		motional commission members voted in favor of the COA. Steve Siebe said it	
113		was commendable that The City of Florissant will spend the extra money and	
114		repair the home with period shingles. He expressed the importance of repairs to a	
115		home that is on the National Historic Register.
