Florissant waste pick-up days depend on the area in which you live. The recycle and yard waste service will be the day prior to your trash pick-up. Please have all trash, recycling and yard waste to the curb no later than 6:00 am on your scheduled day.

**Trash and Recycle Service Pricing:**

\$15.50 per month

Senior Rate: \$7.75 per month

**Weekly Pick-Up Limits:**

210 gallon limit per pick-up

Anything over the limit will be charged \$2.50 per bag (Senior Rate: \$1.25 per bag) and must be scheduled with our office 24 hours prior to pick-up

**Yard Waste Service:**

\$8.50 per month if service is provided 3 months at a time, with the service limited to 210 gallons per pick-up (Once service is started it must be kept until the end of the billing cycle)

Senior rate: \$4.25 per month

\$8.15 per month for unlimited collection if service provided all year (Service must be kept for 12 consecutive months)

Senior Rate: \$4.08 per month



**Once a week pick-up**

Unlimited collection if service is provided all year  
210 gallon limit per pick-up if service is provided 3 months at a time

Anything over the limit will be charged \$2.50 per bag (Senior Rate: \$1.25 per bag) and must be scheduled with our office 24 hours prior to pick-up

**Cart Rental**

One 96 gallon cart will be provided to all residential customers

If additional carts are needed by a customer there is a monthly \$3.50 rental fee for each additional cart, with Seniors receiving a 50% discount

**Bulk Items**

Bulk pick-up is available on the 3rd pick-up of the month when scheduled with Gateway Disposal in advance.

There is no charge for 2 items of 60 lbs. or less during the calendar year

Additional bulk items or items in excess of 60 pounds: \$15 per item

Senior rate: \$7.50 per item

**White Goods**

\$20.00 per item

Senior rate: \$10.00

White good pick-up must be scheduled with Gateway Disposal office 24 hours prior to pick up
