NEW BUSINESS

Member Update:

Peggy Hogan announced we now have 17 members. Peggy welcomed a new Senior Commission member Lisa Smith. Peggy stated we have room for one more member, to keep in mind if you know anyone interested.

Memorial Day Event:

- Tickets: The Senior Office started selling tickets on Monday May 2, 2022. Ticket prices are \$16.00 for residents and \$19.00 for non-residents.
- Menu Tornatores: Chicken breast with gravy, baby butter potatoes, seasoned green beans, salad, rolls, & cherry pie. Senior Commission decided to put a small bowl with salt and pepper on each table.

Carnival:

- Tickets: The Carnival will take place on Thursday June 30, 2022. The Senior Office will start selling tickets on Monday June 6, 2022 for \$16.00 for residents and \$19.00 for nonresidents.

- Games: We will have a Duck Pond, Sucker Pull, Ring Bottle Toss, Tic Tac Toe, and a Cake Walk. The Cake Walk will be sponsored by the Senior Office Staff. St. Catherine Retirement, DeSmet Retirement, Delmar Gardens, and Archwell Health will sponsor all other games. Sponsors will have their game prizes, we encouraged them to have food items. Consolation prizes will be items with their logo.

- Decorations: Centerpieces to use colorful flower sprays, and bright colored tablecloths.
- Entertainment: Mayor Lowery will be calling Bingo.
- Bingo Prizes: Senior Commission has decided to have 15 games. We will have up to \$500.00 in cash to purchase prizes. Many ideas were discussed for prizes.
