5 The Florissant City Council met in regular session at Florissant City Hall, 955 rue St. Francois on 6 Monday, August 8, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. with Council President Eagan presiding. The Chair asked everyone 7 in attendance to stand and join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

8 On Roll Call the following Councilmembers were present: Harris, Manganelli, Eagan, Caputa, 9 Schildroth, Mulcahy, Pagano, Parson, and Siam. Also present was Mayor Timothy Lowery, Deputy City 10 Clerk Savanna Burton, and City Attorney John Hessel. A quorum being present the Chair stated that the 11 Council Meeting was in session for the transaction of business.

12 Councilman Harris moved to approve City Council Minutes of July 25, 2022, seconded by 13 Manganelli. Motion carried.

The next item on the Agenda was Commendations.

16 The Chair stated the next item on the agenda was Hearing from Citizens.

17 Lucia Greer, 2360 Love Lane, stated VFW Post 444 is not for sale and they are trying to 18 reinvigorate the post while rejoining the community. Ms. Greer noted the post is located on 9 acres 19 directly along the river. She noted they have a monthly market with local small businesses, allows for 20 boy scouts to camp on the property, and will be happy to allow for events to be hosted which may have 21 otherwise been canceled due to the flooding.

22 Marvin Tobias, 1826 Woodridge, stated his appreciation for the city's response to the flooding 23 by waiving fees for inspections and for the aquatics center.

The Chair stated that the next item on the agenda was *Public Hearings*.

25 The City Clerk reported that Public Hearing 22-08-018 for the Request to authorize a Special Use 26 Permit to Imo's Pizza for the operation of a carry-out, drive-thru restaurant located at 1725 Washington. 27 The Chair declared the Public Hearing open.

28 Rob Jacknewitz, 2324 Hampton Ave, noted Imo's is wanting to repair the façade of the old 29 Krone's Auto Repair. He stated the business would have a screened walk-in cooler, dumpster enclosure, 30 new paving and striping to the parking lot, and landscaping. Mr. Jacknewitz added the business would

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only allow for drive-through, carry-out, and delivery with hours of operation from 10am to midnight. He stated the project would take around 4 to 5 months to complete. Mr. Jacknewitz noted the New Halls Ferry business is still in the process of the build and will be opening, however this project will be completed quicker due to the building being in manageable shape.

- The City Clerk reported that Public Hearing 22-08-019 for the Request to authorize a Special Use
 Permit to Dalind J Enterprises to allow for a Car Sales business located at 1735 S New Florissant Rd in
 a 'B-3' Extensive Business District. The Chair declared the Public Hearing open.

Dewandra Palmer, petitioner, stated the business needs a brick and mortar location to obtain a dealer's license for the State of Missouri. The business buys cars from auction based on customer requests. She stated the building would have four designated parking spaces for vehicles which are waiting to be picked up and one security camera would be facing the vehicles. The building would hold the office where paperwork would be handled. She stated no detailing or cleaning of cars would take place at the business and vehicles are bought as is. Ms. Palmer noted the business would be open from 9am to 5pm Monday through Saturday.

Marvin Tobias, 1826 Woodridge, wanted clarification on the timeline of the remodel and what changed to make the budget increase for the locker room and if the weight room request was included in this budget change.

162 Councilman Schildroth made a motion to suspend the rules to speak with Chief Fagan, seconded163 by Eagan. Motion carried.

164 Chief Fagan noted the weight room project was completed and is not included in the request for 165 budget adjustments. He stated the project has been pulled out of requests for many years due to saving 166 the money for this year. Chief Fagan noted the budget proposed for the project was a guess and the request 167 is based off the contactor selection and bid information. The request is the actual cost of the construction 168 since the lockers were previously purchased. Councilman Schildroth noted the Forfeiture Revenue 169 account is funded by arrests which are made by the police department and the property that is seized. 170 Chief Fagan noted the lockers were purchased early to prevent it costing about \$9,000 more. He clarified 171 the donations account was given to the police department from a trust which was recently acquired and 172 a portion of the money has been left behind.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL AS A WHOLE AUGUST 22, 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE FLORISSANT CITY COUNCIL CONGRATULATING COUNCILMAN JEFF CAPUTA ON HIS RETIREMENT AFTER 36 YEARS AS A CEMENT MASON.

WHEREAS, Jeff Caputa and his wife Terri have been residents of the City of Florissant for 35 years; and

WHEREAS, Jeff and Terri have three children, Michael, Jeffrey and Kelsey, son in law Bill, and granddaughter Maggie; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Caputa was elected as the Council representative for Ward 4 in 2013, has served as Council President and Chair of the Pool Sub-Committee and;

WHEREAS, Jeff proudly served in the Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, Jeff became a journeyman cement mason in January of 1986, and performed his trade on commercial, residential and municipal projects and;

WHEREAS, Jeff served as an instructor in the Job Corps Program for four years, training young people to become cement masons; and

WHEREAS, Jeff is a 36-year member of Cement Masons Local 527; and

WHERAS, after 36 years, Jeff Caputa is retiring from the Cement Masons.

December 1, 2017, was the implementation of the last salary ordinance for the City of Florissant's police officers and command staff. So much has changed in the world of policing and in the economy. Reviewing the marketplace and numerous survey studies, the City of Florissant falls in the bottom for minimum and maximum pay rates for police officers. To attract the experience, knowledge and quality of applicants that we need to serve our community and maintain the standards held in our City we strongly recommend we visit a new pay schedule for our police department.

November 2001, is the last ordinance where a change was made and outlined the compensation for the Mayor and City Council. In 2006 and 2004, respectively were the last years the two received any additional compensation. It is definitely time for those in these demanding elected positions be compensated to reflect the increased responsibilities and continuous changes in the economy.

The Florissant Mayor's position I view as one similar to the City Manager/Administrator position of the many municipalities we compete. The responsibilities are to run the day-to-day operations of the City and manage all employees, along with serving our residents. Our Mayor's compensation should be in line with those with similar functions and responsibilities. I recommend a $10 \frac{1}{2}\%$ increase (new salary: \$149,999) effective with the next election April 2023. The new rate I believe is still below what a normal annual three percent increase over that time would have yielded. However, this rate will help the City maintain and attract future strong candidates to lead our community.

The City Council serves as the legislative body of the City. The council looks to the city's goals, major projects and infrastructure improvements ranging from community growth to land use to finances and strategic planning. The Council's time extends well beyond the meetings on Monday nights. Therefore, I recommend the Council adjust accordingly by 10 ½% (new annual rate: \$12,782) to be effective beginning with the next election April 2023. Note: current Council members will not be effective until the time of their re-election and successful appointment.

This adjustment will help us continue to attract future candidates for Mayor and City Council willing to be of service to our community. If you need additional information or have any questions feel free to contact me.
