| 54 | Phil Lum welcomed Dan Sullivan and Lou Jearls to the Planning and Zoning Commission and |

| 61 | Request recommended approval of a Special Use Permit for the operation of a billiard parlor, |
| 62 | located in a 'B-3' Extensive Business District. |
| 63 | Phil Lum noted the special use is located in a 'B-3' Extensive Business District and use 4,105 |
| 64 | sq. ft. of the shopping center noted as "Building C" on the site plans. He stated parking currently |
| 65 | complies for the main building and a 6-foot fence on the back of the property with no additional |
| 66 | landscaping proposed. Darryl Wallace, petitioner, noted he wants the establishment to be non-smoking |
| 67 | and one day sell food and beer, but is wanting to open the business with the billiard tables only to |
| 68 | begin. He stated the future plan is to expand to have pizza, nachos, and other similar food as well and a |

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69 beer and wine package liquor license. Mr. Wallace stated the sign on the building would comply with 70 the city code. Additionally, Mr. Wallace wants the sign to be visible from Lindbergh and likely a box-71 sign style. He noted there would not be an age limit at this time but could change that upon request with

hours of operation being from 11am to 11pm.

Chairman Olds made a motion for recommended approval of a Special Use Permit to allow for a billiard parlor establishment in a 'B-3' Extensive Business District as shown on drawings attached, A100 by DESIGNAR LLC and site plan A0-1 dated 10/24/22 by Nova Group Inc., subject to the conditions set forth below with these conditions being part of the record.

The motion was seconded by Martine. On roll call the Commission voted: Baranowski yes,
Minks yes, Olds yes, Martine yes, Sullivan yes, and Jearls yes. Motion passed.
