November 28, 2022

The Florissant City Council met in regular session at Florissant City Hall, 955 rue St. Francois on Monday, November 28, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. with Council President Eagan presiding. The Chair asked everyone in attendance to stand and join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

On Roll Call the following Councilmembers were present: Schildroth, O'Donnell, Pagano, Parson, Harris, Manganelli, Eagan, and Caputa. Councilman Siam was excused. Also present was Mayor Timothy Lowery, City Clerk Karen Goodwin, and City Attorney John Hessel. A quorum being present the Chair stated that the Council Meeting was in session for the transaction of business.

Councilman Siam moved to approve City Council Meeting Minutes November 14, 2022, seconded by Harris. Motion carried.

The Chair stated the next item on the agenda was *Hearing from Citizens*.

Julius Gleghorn, 785 Bellarmine Ln, noted he bought a house about 19 months ago and has continued to have various issues with his neighbors even after making complaints and is concerned about damage to his property and the safety of his family. Councilman Eagan noted two officers have been assigned to resolve the issue and noted he would reach out to Mr. Gleghorn to discuss more options.

The Chair stated that the next item on the agenda was *Public Hearings*.

The City Clerk reported that Public Hearing 22-11-025 for the Request to approve Special Use Permit to Behind the 8 Ball, LLC for the operation of a billiard parlor located at 1165 N. Highway 67. The Chair declared the Public Hearing open.

Darryl Wallace, owner, stated he would like to open a billiard parlor in Florissant and would like to have a place where people can come play pool with about 12 tables and 6 dart boards. He noted he would like to have a few vending machines and eventually sell beer and wine inside the business. Mr. Wallace noted this is a social business and would like to open it up to couples rather than groups of people as well as holding tournaments. He stated he would not allow smoking inside the building and wants to gear the business towards residents and invest in the community. Mr. Wallace hoped to be open from 11am to 11pm and would not like to have restrictions on age to allow families to bring their kids to come in and play. He noted he did not want to turn anyone away but wanted to keep the business operating appropriately. Mr. Wallace stated he would eventually like to add pizza and nachos to a menu to allow

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- 32 for patrons to have something to eat and would like to charge \$10 per table per hour, not a per person 33 charge. Councilman Eagan requested all the back doors to the business remain closed to keep the noise 34 down for the residents. Mr. Wallace clarified the food area would not be a full restaurant area, but 35 prepackaged food like TJ's pizza and a pizza oven as well as nachos in packaging and a cheese machine. 36 Councilman Manganelli asked Mr. Wallace to keep trash off the lot. Mr. Wallace stated he will police 37 his own lot and clean up the area to make sure his lot and business are continually clean. He noted a wall-38 style jukebox would be there for the ambiance rather than noise and the televisions would be used for the 39 same purposes. Mr. Wallace noted no intention for dancing events, parties, or rentals because the only 40 purpose is for a billiard parlor.

The event is taking place at 627 St. Francois next to the Jess & Co. Realty Company.

(See Attachment 2 - Operating Agreement dated 2/10/20)

3. In or around October/November 2020, I decided to establish a physical location.

- On November 17, 2020. I registered Plush Lounge as a fictitious entity identifying myself as the sole owner. (See Attachment 3 - Application for Fictitious Name Registration)
- On December 1, 2020, I signed the lease for 12667 New Halls Ferry Rd., Florissant, Missouri 63033 with the intent to operate Plush Lounge as a restaurant and par. I signed the lease as the sole business owner. (See Attachment 4 – Commercial Lease dated 12/1/20)
- On December 1, 2020, I submitted the first liquor license application with City of Florissant. I was originally advised that I could pick up my pusiness license, occupancy permit and liquor license at the same time. I never received notice of expiration, cancellation or other correspondence.
- 7. In or around November 2021, I reapplied for liquor license with City of Florissant. I was advised by the City Council that per the Florissant Building Inspector my kitchen was not ready or operable. I was advised to get kitchen repaired and return to council once it was completed.
- I had already expended a large sum of money preparing the building and had several unforeseen expenses arise that were not calculated in my initial start-up pudget.
- I began reaching out to friends trying to secure loans and/or find interested investors
 in order to raise capital to make necessary repairs to bring kitchen up to code
 (approximately \$35,000).
- 10. Jesse Akins was introduced to me as a successful event promoter by a mutual friend of ours.
- 11. In or around late November/early December 2021, I met with Mr. Akins personally to discuss his potential engagement at Plush Lounge and at the conclusion of that initial meeting we had verbally agreed on a partnership deal.
- On December 4, 2021, I immediately undertook steps to memorialize the verbal agreement by adding Mr. Akins to the business with filing an Amendment to the Articles of Organization with the Missouri Secretary of State. (See Attachment 5 – Amendment to Articles of Organization dated 12/4/21).
- 13. I learned of Mr. Akins' felony record upon submitting his information to the building owner so that Mr. Akins could be added to the commercial lease agreement for Plush Lounge. The background results came back approximately 2-3 weeks after the information was submitted and the Articles of Organization amendment had been filed.
- 14. Once I was notified that Mr. Akins had a felony conviction, I immediately advised him that I would be unable to proceed with the partnership as agreed and we mutually released from the deal. The partnership agreement was never executed. I

- admittedly failed to file a new amendment to the Articles of Organization removing Jesse Akins in error.
- 15. I agreed to hire Mr. Akins as my promotion manager on a contract basis (1099 worker) until Plush is open and fully operable at which time, we could revisit the arrangement and potentially transition him to a full-time W-9 employee.

- 18. The sworn statements contained in the Affidavit of Ownership, Control and Interest dated November 10, 2022 and submitted with the "new" application filed with the City of Florissant were only intended to represent their accuracy as of the date the affidavit was executed and thereafter.
- 19. I was unaware that Mr. Akins represented himself to be the "manager" of Plush Lounge to Police Officer Fels on May 27, 2022 until November 21, 2022 via the email received from Florissant City Attorney John Hessel.

- If applying for a PACKAGE LIQUOR LICENSE, applicant must contact the Building
 Commissioner prior to applying in order to verify zoning requirements and to determine if a
 Special Use Permit is required. According to the State Statute, the city must also determine
 whether there is a church, school, or playground located within 100 feet of the proposed site
 of business. Once determined, the applicant must then fill out a liquor license application.
- 2. If applying for a BY THE DRINK LIQUOR LICENSE, the Public Works Department will provide a list of the property addresses within 200 feet of the proposed establishment for which the applicant must obtain signatures. According to State Statute, the city must determine whether there is a church, school, or playground located within 100 feet of the proposed site of business.
- 3. Once the liquor license application has been submitted and reviewed by the City Clerk's Office, the application will be placed upon the City Council agenda for approval. It is recommended that the applicant contact the Councilperson of the Ward in which the business is located who will introduce their liquor license for approval. The license request will require a majority vote of the City Council for approval.
- The day following the City Council Meeting, the City Clerk upon request by the applicant, can issue a letter of approval to the State Liquor Control.
- The approved liquor license, business license, and commercial occupancy permit must be obtained prior to the opening of the establishment.

(individually the "Member" and collectively the "Members")

BACKGROUND

- A The Members wish to associate themselves as members of a limited liability company
- B The terms and conditions of this Agreement will govern the members within the limited hability company.

IN CONSIDERATION OF and as a condition of the Members entering into this Agreement and other valuable consideration, the receipt and

sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

Formation

1 By this Agreement the Members form a Limited Liability Company (the "Company") in accordance with the laws of the State of Missouri. The rights and obligations of the Members will be as stated in Chapter 347 of the Missouri Revised Statutes (the "Act") except as otherwise provided here.

Nam

2 The name of the Company will be Florisaant Brewing LLC.

Purpose

3. The purpose of this company is to produce, sell, and distribute craft beer.

Term

4 The Company will continue until terminated as provided in this Agreement or may dissolve under conditions provided in the Ast.

Place of Business

5 The Principal Office of the Company will be located at 1595 N. US Hwy 67. Florissant, MO, 63031 or such other place as the Members may from time to time designate

Capital Contributions

6. The following is a list of all Members and their Initial Capital Contributions to the Company. Each of the Members agree to make their Capital Contributions to the Company, full and on time, according to the following terms:

Distribution of Profits/Losses

- 7. Subject to the other provisions of this Agreement, the Net Profits or Losses of the Company, for both accounting and tax purposes, will accrue to and be borne by the Members in proportion to the credit balances in their Capital Accounts.
- 8. Distributions will be made according to the following schedule: Distributions are to be made quarterly.
- Tax Allocations will be borne by the Members in proportion to the credit balances in their Capital Accounts.
- 10. No Member will have priority over any other Member for the distribution of Net Profits or Losses.

Voting

11. Each Member will have a single equal vote on any matter.

Nature of Interest

12. A Member's interest in the Company will be considered personal property.

Withdrawal of Contribution

13. No Member will withdraw any portion of their Capital Contribution without the unanimous consent of the other Members.

Liability for Contribution

14. A Member's obligation to make their required Capital Contribution can only be compromised or released with the consent of all remaining Members or as described elsewhere in this Agreement. If a Member does not make the Capital Contribution when it is due, he is obligated at the option of the remaining Members to contribute cash equal to the agreed value of the Capital Contribution. This option is in addition to and not in lieu of any others rights, including the right to specific performance that the Company may have against the Member.

Additional Contributions

- 15. Capital Contributions may be amended from time to time, according to the requirements of the Company provided that the Members' interests are not affected, except with the unanimous consent of the Members. No Member will be required to make Additional Contributions. Whenever additional capital is determined to be required and an individual Member is unwilling or unable to meet the additional contribution requirement within a reasonable period, as required by business obligations, the remaining Members may contribute in proportion to their existing Capital Contributions to resolve the amount in default. In such case the allocation of Net Profits or Losses of the Company among all the Members may be adjusted to reflect the aggregate change in Capital Contributions by the Members.
- 16. Any advance of money to the Company by any Member in excess of the amounts provided for in this Agreement or subsequently agreed to, will be deemed a debt due from the Company rather than an increase in the Capital Contribution of the Member. This liability will be repaid with interest at such rates and times to be determined by a majority of the Members. This liability will not entitle the lending Member to any increased share of the Company's profits nor to a greater voting power. Resolution of such debts may have preference or priority over any other payments to Members as may be determined by a majority of the Members.

Capital Accounts

17. An individual capital account will be maintained for each Member and their initial Capital Contribution will be credited to this account. Any Additional Contributions made by any Member will be credited to that Member's individual Capital Account.

Interest on Capital

18. No borrowing charge or loan interest will be due or payable to any Member on their agreed Capital Contribution inclusive of any agreed

Additional Contributions.

Drawing Accounts

19. An individual drawing account will be maintained for each Member. Each Member will be entitled to draw against their share of the profits in such amounts and at such time as will be agreed by the Members. The drawing account is a temporary account and is expected to have a debit balance if there have been any withdrawals. At the end of each accounting year, the drawing accounts are closed by transferring the debit balance to each Member's capital account.

Compensation of Members for Services Rendered

20. Members will be compensated by the Company for services rendered to or on behalf of the Company.

Management

21. Management of this Company is vested in the Members.

Authority to Bind Company

22. Only the following individuals have authority to bind the Company in contract: All members.

Duty of Loyalty

23. No Member or Manager will engage in any business, venture or transaction, whether directly or indirectly, that might be competitive with the business of the Company or that would be in direct conflict of interest to the Company. Any potential conflicts of interest will be deemed an Involuntary Withdrawal of the offending Member or Manager and may be treated accordingly by the remaining Members. A withdrawing Member or Manager will not carry on a similar business to the business of the Company within any established or market regions of the Company for a period of at least 2 years after the date of withdrawal.

Duty to Devote Time

24. Each Member will devote such time and attention to the business of the Company as the majority of the Members will from time to time reasonably determine for the conduct of the Company business.

Member Meetings

- 25. Member meetings will be held at the following address, or any other location that the Members may from time to time designate: 1595 N. US Hwy 67, Florissant, MO, 63031.
- 26. Any impending Member meeting will require 1 day notice be given to all Members.
- 27. A meeting may be called by any Member providing that appropriate notice has been provided to the other Members.
- 28. There must be at least 100.00% of the Members present at a meeting for any decisions to be binding. If the minimum number of Members are not present at the meeting, actions may still be taken by the present Members if prior written consent of the absent Members has been obtained.

Admission of New Members

- 29. A new Member may only be admitted to the Company with a unanimous vote of the existing Members.
- 30. The new Member agrees to be bound by all the covenants, terms, and conditions of this Agreement, inclusive of all current and future amendments. Further, a new Member will execute such documents as are needed to effect the admission of the new Member. Any new Member will receive such business interest in the Company as determined by a unanimous decision of the other Members.

Voluntary Withdrawal of a Member

31. No Member may voluntarily withdraw from the Company for a period of 1 year from the execution date of this Agreement. Any such unauthorized withdrawal prior to the expiration of this period will be

considered a wrongful dissociation and a breach of this Operating Agreement. In the event of any such wrongful dissociation, the withdrawing Member will be liable to the remaining Members for any damages incurred by the remaining Members including but not limited to the loss of future earnings. After the expiration of this period, any Member will have the right to voluntarily withdraw from the Company. Written notice of intention to withdraw must be served upon the remaining Members at least 6 months prior to withdrawal.

- 32. The voluntary withdrawal of a Member will have no effect upon the continuance of the Company.
- 33. It remains incumbent on the withdrawing Member to exercise this dissociation in good faith and to minimize any present or future harm done to the remaining Members as a result of the withdrawal.

Involuntary Withdrawal of a Member

34. Events leading to the involuntary withdrawal of a Member from the Company will include but not be limited to: death of a Member; Member mental incapacity; Member disability preventing reasonable participation in the Company; Member incompetence; breach of fiduciary duties by a Member; criminal conviction of a Member; Operation of Law against a Member or a legal judgment against a Member that can reasonably be expected to bring the business or societal reputation of the Company into disrepute.

Expulsion of a Member can also occur on application by the Company or another Member, where it has been judicially determined that the Member: has engaged in wrongful conduct that adversely and materially affected the Company's business; has wilfully or persistently committed a material breach of the Operating Agreement or of a duty owed to the Company or to the other Members; or has engaged in conduct relating to the Company's business that makes it not reasonably practicable to carry on the business with the Member.

35. The involuntary withdrawal of a Member will have no effect upon the continuance of the Company.

Dissociation of a Member

- 36. In the event of either a voluntary or involuntary withdrawal of a Member, if the remaining Members elect to purchase the interest of the withdrawing Member, the remaining Members will serve written notice of such election, including the purchase price and method and schedule of payment for the withdrawing Member's interest, upon the withdrawing Member, their executor, administrator, trustee, committee or analogous fiduciary within a reasonable period after acquiring knowledge of the change in circumstance to the affected Member. The purchase amount of any buyout of a Member's interest will be determined as outlined in the Valuation of Interest section of this Agreement.
- 37. In the event the remaining Members are unwilling or unable to purchase the interest of the Dissociated Member due to a voluntary or involuntary withdrawal from the Company then the Members will submit to mediation and, if necessary, binding arbitration for a final resolution. Valuation and distribution will be determined as described in the Valuation of Interest section of this Agreement.
- 38. The remaining Members retain the right to seek damages from a dissociated Member where the dissociation resulted from a malicious or criminal act by the dissociated Member or where the dissociated Member had breached their fiduciary duty to the Company or was in breach of this Agreement or had acted in a way that could reasonably be foreseen to bring harm or damage to the Company or to the reputation of the Company.
- 39. On any purchase and sale resulting from the voluntary or involuntary dissociation of a Member, a dissociated Member will only have liability for Company obligations that were incurred during their time

as a Member. Immediately upon purchase of a withdrawing Member's interest, the Company will prepare, file, serve, and publish all notices required by law to protect the withdrawing Member from liability for future Company obligations. Where the remaining Members have purchased the interest of a dissociated Member, the purchase amount will be paid in full, but without interest, within 90 days of the date of withdrawal. The Company will retain exclusive rights to use of the trade name and firm name and all related brand and model names of the Company.

Buyout Agreement

40. In the event of a Member's interest in the Company becoming for sale, due to any reason, the remaining Members of the Company have a right of first purchase on the interest. The value of the interest in the Company will be determined as outlined in the Valuation of Interest section of this Agreement.

Assignment of Interest

- 41. A Member's financial interest in the Company can only be assigned to another Member and cannot be assigned to a third party.
- 42. In the event that a Member's interest in the company is transferred or assigned as the result of a court order or Operation of Law, the trustee in bankruptcy or other person acquiring that Member's interest in Company will only acquire that Member's economic rights and interests and will not acquire any other rights of that Member or be admitted as a Member of the Company or have the right to exercise any management or voting interests.

Valuation of Interest

- 43. In the absence of a written agreement setting a value, the value of the Company will be based on the fair market value appraisal of all Company assets (less liabilities) determined in accordance with generally accepted accounting procedures. This appraisal will be conducted by an independent accounting firm agreed to by all Members. An appraiser will be appointed within a reasonable period of the date of withdrawal or dissolution. The results of the appraisal will be binding on all Members. A withdrawing Member's interest will be in proportion to their profit and loss share in the Company, less any outstanding liabilities a Member may have to the Company. The intent of this section is to ensure the survival of the Company despite the withdrawal of any individual Member.
- 44. No allowance will be made for goodwill, trade name, patents or other intangible assets, except where those assets have been reflected on the Company books immediately prior to valuation.

Dissolution

- 45. The Company may be dissolved by a unanimous vote of the Members. The Company will also be dissolved on the occurrence of events specified in the Act.
- 46. Upon Dissolution of the Company and liquidation of Company property, and after payment of all selling costs and expenses, the liquidator will distribute the Company assets to the following groups according to the following order of priority:
 - a. in satisfaction of liabilities to creditors except Company obligations to current Members:
 - b. in satisfaction of Company obligations to current Members to pay debts; and
 - c. to the Members in proportion to their profit and loss share in the Company.

47. The claims of each priority group will be satisfied in full before satisfying any claims of a lower priority group. Any excess of Company assets after liabilities or any insufficiency in Company assets in resolving liabilities under this section will be resolved by the Members in proportion to the profit and loss share of each Member as set out in this Agreement.

Records

- 48. The Company will at all times maintain accurate records of the following:
 - a. Information regarding the status of the business and the financial condition of the Company.
 - b. A copy of the Company federal, state, and local income taxes for each year (promptly after becoming available).
 - c. Name and last known business, residential, or mailing address of each Member, as well as the date that person became a Member.
 - d. A copy of this Agreement and any articles or certificate of formation, as well as all amendments, together with any executed copies of any written powers of attorney pursuant to which this Agreement, articles or certificate, and any amendments have been executed.
 - e. The cash, property, and services contributed to the Company by each Member, along with a description and value, and any contributions that have been agreed to be made in the future.
- 49. Each Member has the right to demand, within a reasonable period of time, a copy of any of the above documents for any purpose reasonably related to their interest as a Member of the Company, at their expense.

Books of Account

50. Accurate and complete books of account of the transactions of the Company will be kept and at all reasonable times be available and open to inspection and examination by any Member. The Books of Account will be kept on the accrual basis method of accounting.

Banking and Company Funds

51. The funds of the Company will be placed in such investments and banking accounts as will be designated by the Members. All withdrawals from these accounts will be made by the duly authorized agent or agents of the Members as agreed by unanimous consent of the Members. Company funds will be held in the name of the Company and will not be commingled with those of any other person or entity.

Audit

52. Any of the Members will have the right to request an audit of the Company books. The cost of the audit will be borne by the Company. The audit will be performed by an accounting firm acceptable to all the Members. Not more than one (1) audit will be required by any or all of the Members for any fiscal year.

Fiscal Year End

53. The fiscal year end of the Company is the 1st day of January.

Tax Treatment

54. This Company is intended to be treated as a corporation, for the purposes of Federal and State Income Tax.

Annual Report

- 55. As soon as practicable after the close of each fiscal year, the Company will furnish to each Member an annual report showing a full and complete account of the condition of the Company including all information as will be necessary for the preparation of each Member's income or other tax returns. This report will consist of at least:
 - a. A copy of the Company's federal income tax returns for that fiscal year.
 - b. A balance sheet.
 - c. A cash flow statement.
 - d. A breakdown of the profit and loss attributable to each Member.

Goodwill

56. The goodwill of the Company will be assessed at an amount to be determined by appraisal using generally accepted accounting procedures.

Governing Law

57. The Members submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Missouri for the enforcement of this Agreement or any arbitration award or decision arising from this Agreement.

Mediation and Arbitration

58. In the event a dispute arises out of or in connection with this Agreement, the parties will attempt to resolve the dispute through friendly consultation. If the dispute is not resolved within a reasonable period then any or all outstanding issues may be submitted to mediation in accordance with any statutory rules of mediation. If mediation is not successful in resolving the entire dispute or is unavailable, any outstanding issues will be submitted to final and binding arbitration in accordance with the laws of the State of Missouri. The arbitrator's award will be final, and judgment may be entered upon it by any court having jurisdiction within the State of Missouri.

Force Majeure

59. A Member will be free of liability to the Company where the Member is prevented from executing their obligations under this Agreement in whole or in part due to force majeure, such as earthquake, typhoon, flood, fire, and war or any other unforeseen and uncontrollable event where the Member has communicated the circumstance of the event to any and all other Members and where the Member has taken any and all appropriate action to satisfy his duties and obligations to the Company and to mitigate the effects of the event.

Forbidden Acts

- 60. No Member may do any act in contravention of this Agreement.
- 61. No Member may permit, intentionally or unintentionally, the assignment of express, implied or apparent authority to a third party that is not a Member of the Company.

- 62. No Member may do any act that would make it impossible to carry on the ordinary business of the Company.
- 63. No Member will have the right or authority to bind or obligate the Company to any extent with regard to any matter outside the intended purpose of the Company.
- 64. No Member may confess a judgment against the Company.
- 65. Any violation of the above forbidden acts will be deemed an Involuntary Withdrawal of the offending Member and may be treated accordingly by the remaining Members.

Indemnification

66. All Members will be indemnified and held harmless by the Company from and against any and all claims of any nature, whatsoever, arising out of a Member's participation in Company affairs. A Member will not be entitled to indemnification under this section for liability arising out of gross negligence or wilful misconduct of the Member or the breach by the Member of any provisions of this Agreement.

Liability

67. A Member or any employee will not be liable to the Company or to any other Member for any mistake or error in judgment or for any act or omission believed in good faith to be within the scope of authority conferred or implied by this Agreement or the Company. The Member or employee will be liable only for any and all acts and omissions involving intentional wrongdoing.

Liability Insurance

68. The Company may acquire insurance on behalf of any Member, employee, agent or other person engaged in the business interest of the Company against any liability asserted against them or incurred by them while acting in good faith on behalf of the Company.

Life Insurance

69. The Company will have the right to acquire life insurance on the lives of any or all of the Members, whenever it is deemed necessary by the Company. Each Member will cooperate fully with the Company in obtaining any such policies of life insurance.

Actions Requiring Unanimous Consent

- 70. Actions requiring the unanimous consent of all Members will include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - a. Incurring Company liabilities over \$5,000.00.
 - b. Incurring a single transaction expense over \$5,000.00.
 - c. The sale of any Company asset with a fair market value over \$0.00.
 - d. Hiring an employee with an annual compensation over \$0.00.
 - e. Firing any employee.
 - f. Assignment of ownership rights of Company property.
 - g. Endangering the ownership or possession of Company property.

- h. Assignment of check signing authority.
- i. Releasing any Company claim except for payment in full.

Amendment of Operating Agreement

71. No amendment or modification of this Agreement will be valid or effective unless in writing and signed by all the Members.

Title to Company Property

72. Title to all Company property will remain in the name of the Company. No Member or group of Members will have any ownership interest in Company property in whole or in part.

Miscellaneous

- 73. Time is of the essence in this Agreement.
- 74. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts.
- 75. Headings are inserted for the convenience of the parties only and are not to be considered when interpreting this Agreement. Words in the singular mean and include the plural and vice versa. Words in the masculine gender include the feminine gender and vice versa. Words in a neutral gender include the masculine gender and the feminine gender and vice versa.
- 76. If any term, covenant, condition or provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, it is the parties' intent that such provision be reduced in scope by the court only to the extent deemed necessary by that court to render the provision reasonable and enforceable and the remainder of the provisions of this Agreement will in no way be affected, impaired or invalidated as a result.
- 77. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties. All negotiations and understandings have been included in this Agreement. Statements or representations that may have been made by any party to this Agreement in the negotiation stages of this Agreement may in some way be inconsistent with this final written Agreement. All such statements have no force or effect in respect to this Agreement. Only the written terms of this Agreement will bind the parties.
- 78. This Agreement and the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement apply to and are binding upon the Member's successors, assigns, executors, administrators, beneficiaries, and representatives.
- 79. Any notices or delivery required here will be deemed completed when hand-delivered, delivered by agent, or seven (7) days after being placed in the post, postage prepaid, to the parties at the addresses contained in this Agreement or as the parties may later designate in writing.
- 80. All of the rights, remedies and benefits provided by this Agreement will be cumulative and will not be exclusive of any other such rights, remedies and benefits allowed by law.

Additional Terms

81. If a Member is unable to provide additional contributions that are required for start up the other Member(s) can contribute the additional funds acquiring additional percentage of company equity. The Member(s) unable to provide additional funds will be able to purchase back company equity for the first 24 months after contributions are made. i.e. if \$100,000 is required for start up costs and only one Member provides the additional \$10,000 they will acquire 7% giving them company equity of 40%

leaving the remaining Members at 30% with the ability to purchase back 3.33% each for 24 months after contributions are made.

- 82. In the result of a Member's death their company equity can be transferred to a single person predetermined and voted on unanimously by all Members.
- 83. In the result of a Member's inability to perform company duties due to illness or mental incapacities their voting power can be transferred to a single person predetermined and voted on unanimously by all Members.

Definitions

- 84. For the purpose of this Agreement, the following terms are defined as follows:
 - a. "Additional Contribution" means Capital Contributions, other than Initial Contributions, made by Members to the Company.
 - b. "Capital Contribution" means the total amount of cash, property, or services contributed to the Company by any one Member.
 - c. "Initial Contribution" means Capital Contributions made by any Member to acquire an interest in the Company.
 - d. "Net Profits or Losses" means the net profits or losses of the Company as determined by generally accepted accounting principles.
 - e. "Operation of Law" means rights or duties that are cast upon a party by the law, without any act or agreement on the part of the individual including, but not limited to, an assignment for the benefit of creditors, a divorce, or a bankruptcy.
 - f. "Principal Office" means the office whether inside or outside the State of Missouri where the executive or management of the Company maintain their primary office.

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SALES TAX AT A RATE OF THREE PERCENT ON ALL TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY RETAIL SALES OF ADULT USE MARIJUANA SOLD WITHIN THE CITY OF FLORISSANT, MISSOURI, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 2.6(5) OF THE MISSOURI CONSTITUTION SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 4TH, 2023; DESIGNATING THE FORM OF BALLOT; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2022, the electors of the State of Missouri approved Amendment 3 to the Missouri Constitution enacting Section 2 of Article XIV of the Missouri Constitution effective December 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the newly enacted Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution authorizes the City of Florissant, Missouri to impose, by ordinance, an additional sales tax in amount not to exceed three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in such political subdivision subject to approval by voters of the City of Florissant, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Florissant, Missouri to impose a sales tax of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in the City of Florissant, Missouri and to submit the same to the voters of the City for approval by a majority of those voting at the general municipal election to be held on April 4, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FLORISSAN THAT:

<u>SECTION 1 – ADULT USE MARIJUANA SALES TAX.</u> A sales tax at the rate of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in the City of Florissant, Missouri, as authorized by Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution, is hereby imposed. The tax imposed hereunder shall be in addition to any and all other sales taxes allowed by law.

<u>SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. The sales tax imposed by this Ordinance shall not be effective unless approved by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters voting thereon at the General Municipal Election to be held on April 4, 2023, at which election a proposal to authorize the City Council of the City of Florissant, Missouri, to impose the tax herein provided for shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Florissant.
