Warrants Issued in Disturbance with gunshots fired at Applebee's

FLORISSANT, MO- On April 26th, 2019 at approximately 8:15 pm officers responded to the Applebee's located at 2309 US 67 for a report of disturbance with gunshots fired on the parking lot.

Officers arrived very quickly and immediately secured the scene.

Assisting officers who responded were able to apprehend two suspects that were involved in the shooting as well as recover a firearm.

On April 27th, 2019 the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office issued warrants for Unlawful Use of a Weapon (shooting at/from a motor vehicle) on:

Izaiah T. Clark

Black male 03/20/2000

3300 blk of Martin Luther King

St. Louis, MO 63106

Clark admitted to being involved in a disturbance at the Applebee's yesterday evening. The defendant also confessed to shooting a gun in the direction of a group of people.

The other suspect that was arrested is a Juvenile and has been referred to juvenile court.

This was not a random incident.

Clark is being held at the St. Louis County Jail on \$75,000 cash only bond.

The Florissant Police Department remains committed to the safety of our residents and we want to reassure that we will do everything we can to keep that commitment.
