Shopping Center be read for a second time, seconded by Harris.

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Attorney Hessel stated confusion has occurred due to the use being assembly hall and the business name. Mr. Hessel read the definition of an assembly hall which stated is an area to be used for public meetings, meetings of members of an organization, or hall where people can congregate for meetings or social gatherings. Banquets are typically associated with Assembly Halls, though dining does not fit unless it is in conjunction with assembly halls. The music concerts and educational classes are not considered to fit. The educational classes is a special use on its own and the council would be approving two different categories of uses. Mr. Hessel stated the city council would need to make changes to the Bill to allow this use for approval. Councilman Parson stated he would like to give the petitioner an opportunity to discuss with the council the intended use of the property and for the owner to get a better understanding of the requests from the council. Councilman Harris stated based on the petitioner's discussion at the previous meeting, her business description would fit under Assembly Hall.

Councilman Parson made a motion to postpone the vote until the meeting on Monday, August 9, seconded by Harris. Councilwoman Pagano stated most petitioners know they should be attending all meetings regarding their businesses, the business description and intent for the facility was confusing and unclear to the council. Motion failed.

Councilman Caputa moved that Bill no. 9698 be read for a third time, seconded by Pagano. Motion carried and Bill No. 9698 was read for a third time and placed upon its passage.

On roll call the Council voted: Parson yes, Siam yes, Harris yes, Manganelli no, Eagan no, Caputa no, Schildroth no, Mulcahy no, and Pagano no.

### I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This is a request for 'recommended approval' to amend a Special Use Permit, Ord. No. Ord. No. 7065 (as amended by Ord. No. 8207) to amend a Special Use, Ord. No. 7065 (as amended by Ord. No. 8207) to allow an expansion of an Auto Detailing and Vehicle Storage establishment in a 'B-3' Zoning District with fencing and storage of vehicles on the adjacent lot at 2400 N Highway 67.

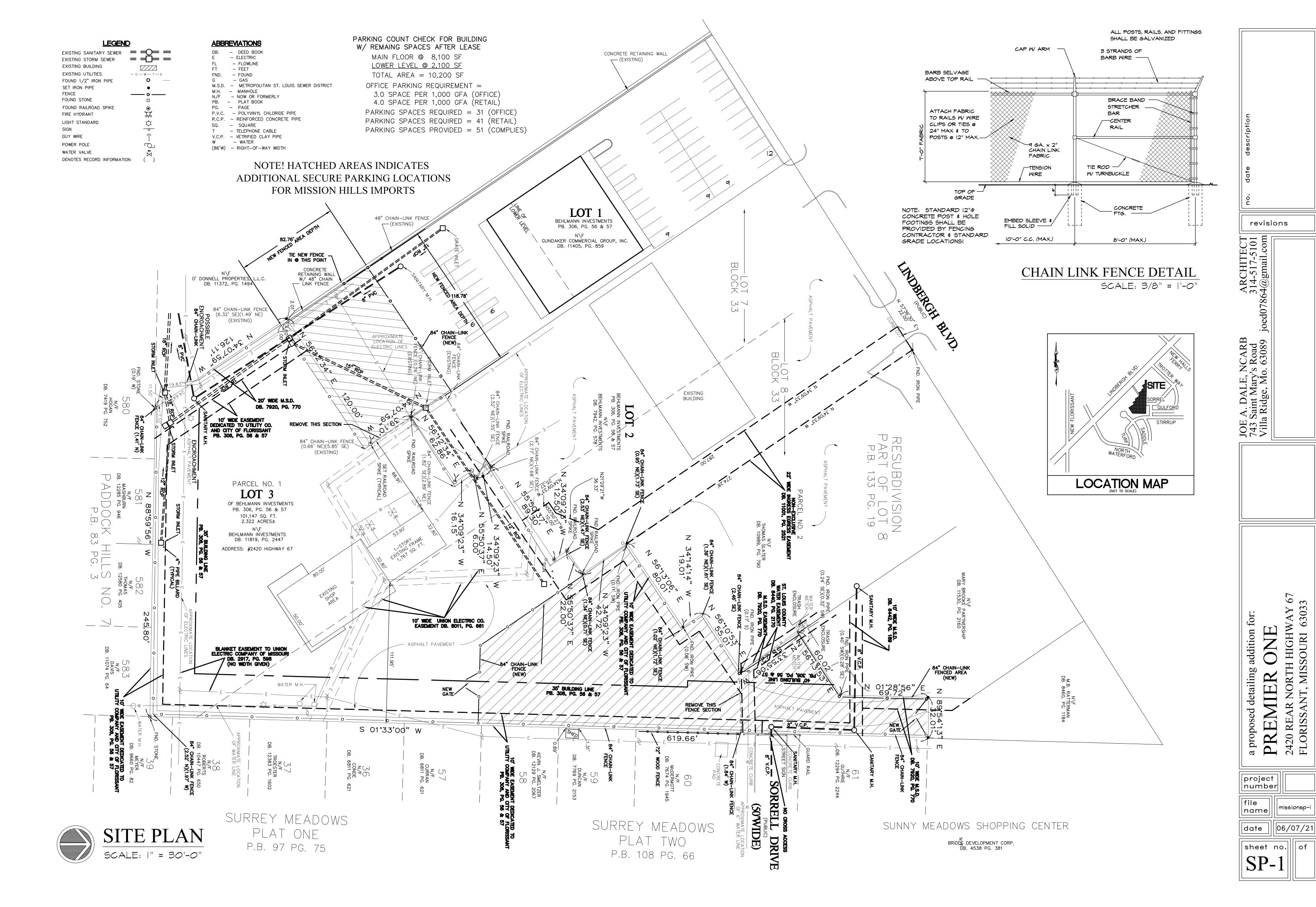
### II. EXISTING SITE CONDITIONS:

The existing property at 2420 rear N. Highway 67 has been operating as a detail shop and is owned by Mission Hills Development Co. Expansion of the Special Use precipitates a need for a new Special Use Permit.

The existing building on the property contains 4239 square feet on 1.6 acres. The building is split-face block and shingle roof. P&Z recommended approval of an addition 30x50 in the rear of matching materials.

The proposal is to fence off a portion of 2400 N Highway 67, with permission, granted by the owner of the properties involved.

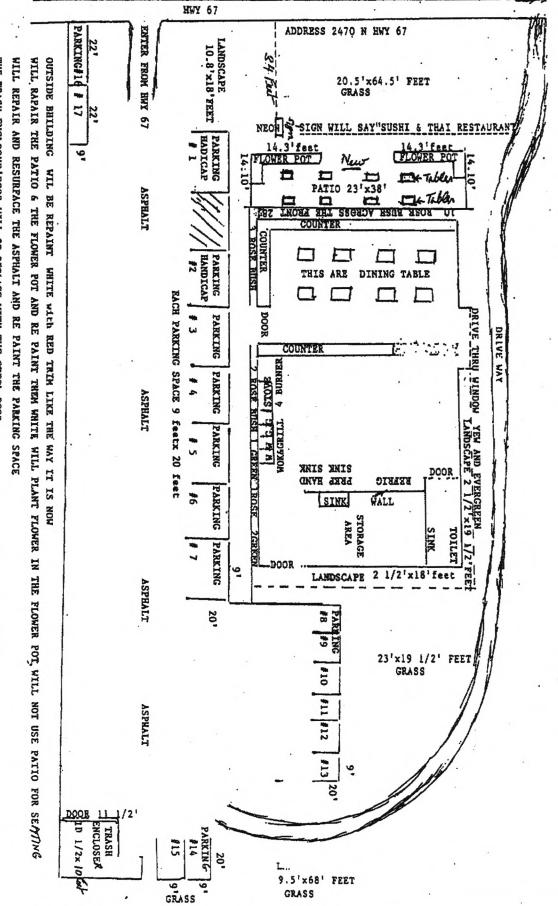

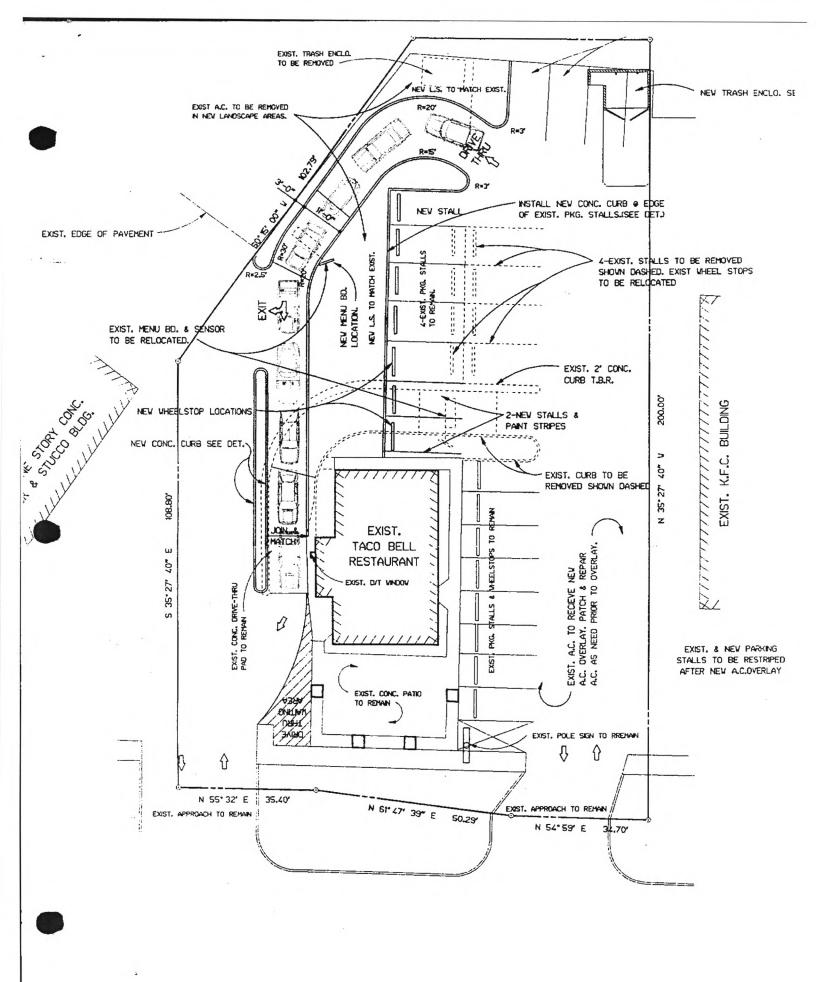

Subject: Police Building Locker Rooms Project

Sir,

In FY 2020, we were unable to complete a locker room project for both the Male and Female locker rooms at the Police Headquarters building. This would be a complete overhaul of the locker rooms, which are in need of repair and updating. We were unable to complete that project due to budget cut backs related to Covid-19. We were unable to place this project in the FY2021 budget again due to budget cutbacks. In speaking with Finance Director, Kimberlee Johnson, she advised that we may now have enough money in Capital Additions (Police Fund) to cover this project. The request for appropriation of funds for the locker room project would be \$120,000. To free up the funds to cover this project; it is requested to remove the Capital Additions line items for the purchase of two Chevrolet Tahoe police vehicle at \$76,000 and the related equipment install of \$4,400 from the FY21 budget. This would be a total of \$80,400. These items will be requested in the FY22 budget.

Thus, the Locker room project at \$120,000 minus \$80,400 would leave a request of \$39,600 additional appropriation of Funds for this project in the FY21 budget from account 17-6100: Capital Additions (police fund).
